St. Clairsville is the county seat of Belmont County. It was originally called Newellstown, named for David Newell who settled here in 1796. In 1803, the town was renamed in honor of General Arthur St. Clair, First Governor of the Northwest Territory, and was designated the Belmont County Seat.

Today through the winds of the time and change St. Clairsville has truly become a modern “*Paradise on the Hilltop.*” St. Clairsville is a residential community with a population of over 5,000 living within the city of four square miles. St. Clairsville is situated high above the Ohio River Valley in the rolling hills of eastern Ohio. Its clean air, quiet evenings, beautiful homes, and tree lined streets provide healthy, comfortable and leisure living for its residents. Medium to expensive priced homes of your choice are available and no city income tax applies. St. Clairsville is a vibrant, changing and progressive city in a rural setting.

St. Clairsville is a paradise in residential living and convenience. St. Clairsville boasts a clean well lighted downtown district with many specialty shops and professional offices.

Conveniently located near St. Clairsville is the Ohio Valley Mall, Ohio Valley Plaza and Plaza West Shopping Center. BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO

Demographics

Belmont County is a 537 square mile tract of land along the Ohio River in eastern Ohio. The county seat is St. Clairsville near the center of Belmont County. It is 10 Miles west of the Ohio River and Wheeling, West Virginia, 65 miles West of Pittsburgh and 110 miles east of Columbus. The city covers an area of four square miles, with National Road (Route 40) serving as the main street of the city. Belmont County is almost an equal distance from New York and Chicago and approximately 300 miles away from Washington, D.C. All of these areas are easily accessible by modern interstate highways.

Belmont County is considered part of the Wheeling Metropolitan Statistical Area, which also includes Marshall and Ohio counties. It extends beyond the county lines in a 50-mile radius, which encompasses more than 600,000 people. Belmont County’s steep hills and narrow valleys offer dramatic scenery as well as abundant supplies of coal, a plentiful water supply, deposits of limestone and clay and a number of recreational facilities. Elevation ranges from 610 to 1,300 feet above sea level.

The residential centers of St. Clairsville, Belmont, Bethesda and Barnesville are also the industrial and commercial growth areas. Communities along the river, such as Martins Ferry, Bellaire and Bridgeport, among others are also highly industrialized and heavily populated. Belmont County is easily accessible to nearly every point in the nation’s industrial heart. It is within 500 miles of two thirds of the nation’s population.

Belmont County's dominant geographic feature is the Ohio River which has cut through hundreds of feet of sedimentary rock deposited when the region was part of an ancient inland sea. Most of the flooding problems that were once common along the river and its tributaries have been solved by the construction of a series of dams.

Deposits of coal, limestone and clay are contained in the area's layers of shale and sandstone rock. The Soil Conservation Service lists two types of local soil, one found along the alluvial plains and lower elevations that can be used for residential and light urban development.

The area enjoys an annual growing season of 180 days. The last frost usually occurs in April and the first fall frost occurring in the late October. Snowfall usually starts in late November with the last spring snow in early April. During the past 20 years, cooling degree days have averaged 686, while heating days have averaged 6035. Average precipitation during that same period has been 36.7 inches with average annual snowfalls of 45 inches.

NATURAL RESOURCES

Coal

Coal continues to be the most abundant natural resource available in Belmont County, which also contains deposits of sand and gravel, some oil and gas, and, of course, the water resources provided by the Ohio River and its numerous stream and creek tributaries.

The most recent figures available are from 1984 by the Ohio Department of Natural Resources. According to this report, Belmont County led the state in coal production for the period in question, with more than six million tons of coal mined. The five leading coal producing counties of Belmont, Harrison, Monroe, Nobel and Meigs produced 54 percent of the state's total.

Transporting the coal was done mostly by truck, with the trucking industry responsible for 41.1 percent of the shipments. Railways took 17.2 percent, water used for 19 percent, conveyor belts carried 22.4 percent and one percent was stored. The coal from Belmont County mines was valued at \$220,183,239.00 and sold at an average price of \$31.62 per ton.

Sand and Gravel

Belmont County sold 244,464 tons of sand during the most recent reporting period, according to ODNR. Most of the sand was also used for Portland cement concrete and bituminous concrete as well as for road construction and resurfacing.

Water

Wells drilled along the river valleys yield more than 300,000 gallons per minute. The Ohio River itself can provide a nearly unlimited supply of process water and water for domestic use. Normal flows measure more than six billion gallons per day. Water quality varies along the river, which is why most water for human consumption comes from wells.

Weather

Four distinct seasons are part of the weather pattern in eastern Ohio. An influx of warm air from the Gulf of Mexico can increase humidity and temperatures during the summer but average of temperatures over a 30-year period shows generally mild summer days, with some highs in the 90's and lows in the 60's and mid 70's with lows in the 40's and 50's. Average winter temperatures can dip to near freezing, but severe cold is uncommon, although winter can produce frequent snow.

Population

Populations as of April 2000 for the city of St. Clairsville are 5,057, Richland Township, 8,514 and Belmont County, 70,226.

Housing

Homes in the city range from \$80,000 to \$1,000,000, with selections from traditional and more contemporary styles. St. Clairsville's larger older homes, (some 80-100 years old) are seldom on the market. Realtors describe homes in the area as "affordable". There is a relatively good selection of homes available and residences generally keep their market value.

Utilities

The city of St. Clairsville has its own electric distribution service with capacity sufficient to service a population of 7,000 or more. Natural Gas is provided by Columbia Gas of Ohio. The main feed size is about eight inches. The water service is city owned. It is supplied by two reservoirs with a capacity to service 7,000 or more residents. The sewage system is owned by the city and was expanded in 1986 to include a newly acquired area west of the city. This addition has greatly increased the development on the west side of St. Clairsville. The telephone service is provided by Ameritech and there are 15 long distance companies to service St. Clairsville.

Government and Services

Since 1977, the city has operated under a Mayor-Council charter form of government with seven council members, one representing each of the four wards and three services at large.

The police department includes the chief and eight full time patrolmen, with four full-time dispatchers. The department uses two cruisers. The county Sheriff's office is located here as well as the Ohio State Highway Patrol Barracks and the Richland Township Police.

The Cumberland Trail Fire District has a full-time Fire Chief who is in charge of a squad of 11 full-time, 12 part-time and seven volunteer fire department personnel, which includes nine paramedics and more than 27 qualified EMT's. Equipment includes five pumper trucks, one which features a 75-foot aerial ladder, a brush fire truck and two fully equipped ambulances. A regular program of building inspections helps provide the city with a low class five fire rating. The department operates from a modern, centrally located station built in 1978.

The St. Clairsville National Road Bikeway



The St. Clairsville National Road Bikeway is more than an asphalt path through the city. The bikeway links neighborhoods, schools, historic and commercial districts, people, parks and other places. The trail was constructed of abandoned railroad lines through St. Clairsville. The property was previously owned and used by the Wheeling and Lake Erie Railroad. It softens the urban landscape and enhances property value. The project serves as an outdoor classroom to the city's natural and built environment. The St. Clairsville National Road Bikeway is a lineal park and an alternative transportation system that enhances the "livability" of the city. This spectacular bikeway is made up of two phases. Phase I is 4.0 miles and Phase II is 3.7 miles, which runs from the school to the Ohio valley Plaza to Memorial Park.
